Headteacher's Message

Dear Parents/Carers,

I have had a small number of parents complain that some adults have been swearing or smoking whilst on the school site. Can I please remind everyone that this type of language and behaviour is completely unacceptable at any school. Adults will be asked to leave the site if necessary. Thank you for your continued support in this matter.

Please note mobile phones should not be used by parents whilst in school without permission. This is a potential safeguarding issue and will be treated as such.

Just a quick reminder that the school will be completely closed on Monday 2nd May due to the May Day Bank Holiday, the school will also be closed to pupils on Thursday 5th May as the school will be used as a Polling Station in the local elections.

As some of you may be aware, my wife is expecting our 3rd child on the 19th May so I will be taking two weeks paternity leave from the day of its arrival. Mrs Frost will be Acting Headteacher for this period and will be ably supported by the Senior Leadership Team.

Some parents have asked about our proposed Time for Twos (TfT) provision. We are in consultation with the Local Authority for turning the Caretaker's House into a TfT Nursery. This is a long winded process involving planning permission etc. so I will keep you posted about the time this Nursery may be launched. It won't be ready for September this year unfortunately.

We finally have an expected completion date for the KS2 playground works. We are hoping the playground will be completely finished ready to start the new school year in September. Despite my best efforts the LA have been very slow in moving this work forward so please accept my apologies for the inconvenience.
