When to get a COVID-19 test

If you have any one of the main symptoms of COVID-19:

- 👉 a new, continuous cough
 - 👉 a high temperature
 - 👉 a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste
- ...you should immediately self-isolate and book a test.

If you are showing any of the following symptoms:

- 👉 headaches
- 👉 aches and pains
- 👉 sore throat
- 👉 runny nose
- 👉 sneezing
- 👉 tummy ache in children
- 👉 feeling very tired for no-good reason

...you are advised to book a test as a precaution. If you have any of these other symptoms you do not need to isolate unless you have a positive test result.
