Dear Parents and Carers,

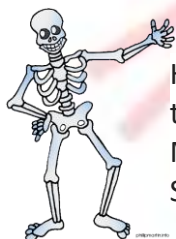
What a half term it has been! Thank you for your support as always so far this year. It has been a slog at times but it is great to finally be back to business as normal.
