Squires - young men who shadowed a Knight with the hopes of becoming a knight themselves.

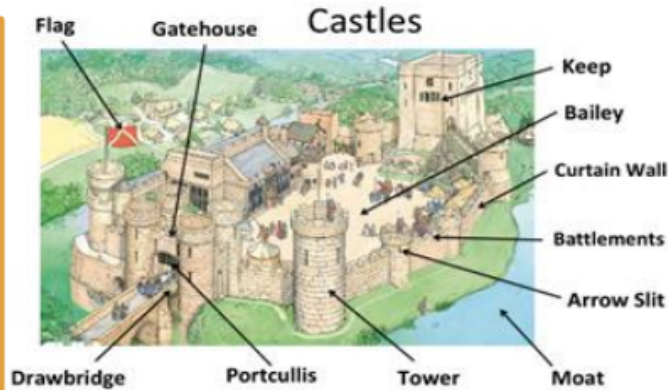
Watchman - An official at the castle responsible for security.
